NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT A MEETING OF THE SCHOOL BOARD OF THE HOUSTON INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT WILL BE HELD ON THE FIFTEENTH DAY OF JUNE 2023 AT 5:30 P.M. AT THE HATTIE MAE WHITE (HMW) EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT CENTER, 4400 WEST 18TH STREET, IN THE BOARD AUDITORIUM, AND SUCH MEETING IS A PUBLIC HEARING, WORKSHOP, AND AGENDA REVIEW. SHOULD THERE BE A NEED TO GO INTO CLOSED SESSION, THIS SESSION MAY BE HELD IN THE BOARD SERVICES CONFERENCE ROOM AT THE HMW EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT CENTER.

THE PURPOSE OF THE HOUSTON INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD IS TO REPRESENT THE VISION AND VALUES OF THE COMMUNITY, AND CONSISTENT WITH THAT, GOVERN THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE HOUSTON INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT IN A MANNER THAT BEST ALLOWS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF ACADEMIC OUTCOMES FOR ALL THE STUDENTS WE SERVE. THE HOUSTON ISD SCHOOL BOARD MUST BE ABLE TO DO ITS WORK OF GOVERNING, INCLUDING DELIBERATIONS AND DECISION-MAKING, IN ORDERLY MEETINGS HELD OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.

IN ORDER TO (I) ENSURE WE CAN EFFICIENTLY ADDRESS THE NEEDS OF OUR STUDENTS, (II) ALLOW FOR NECESSARY DELIBERATIONS AND DISCUSSIONS TO OCCUR, AND (III) GIVE ALL MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC AN OPPORTUNITY TO PARTICIPATE AND OBSERVE THE SCHOOL BOARD'S MEETINGS, WE WILL ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING RULES AND NORMS:

- PUBLIC COMMENT DURING SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS WILL BE LIMITED TO THOSE PERSONS WHO HAVE SIGNED UP TO SPEAK PRIOR TO THE MEETING TIME PER CURRENT PROTOCOL.
- INTERRUPTIONS AND DISRUPTIONS BY PERSONS DURING THE SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE. PERSONS WHO PARTICIPATE IN SUCH

- BEHAVIOR WILL BE GIVEN ONE WARNING AND IF THE BEHAVIOR IS REPEATED, THEY WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE MEETING.
- NO PERSON, UNLESS GIVEN EXPRESS PERMISSION, IS PERMITTED TO APPROACH THE DAIS, PODIUM, OR THE CABINET TABLE(S). PERSONS WHO APPROACH THE DAIS, PODIUM, OR THE CABINET TABLE(S) WITHOUT PERMISSION WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE SCHOOL BOARD MEETING IMMEDIATELY.
- SEATING IN THE BOARD ROOM IS AVAILABLE ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS FOR ALL PERSONS, INCLUDING THOSE WHO HAVE SIGNED UP TO SPEAK DURING PUBLIC COMMENT. OVERFLOW SEATING WILL BE AVAILABLE, ALSO ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS.

A MEMBER OF THE COMMUNITY WISHING TO ADDRESS THE BOARD MAY DO SO IN PERSON OR BY LIVE VIDEO VIA ZOOM. FOR EITHER METHOD, A PERSON WHO WISHES TO ADDRESS THE BOARD MUST REGISTER WITH THE BOARD SERVICES OFFICE BY 12:00 P.M. THE DAY BEFORE THE MEETING.
